



UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS, 2015–2016

OVERVIEW:

The George Washington Forum will award up to five (5) undergraduate research fellowships for the 2015–2016 academic year. The award winners will be mentored by a Washington Forum affiliate faculty members and will provide that faculty member with 4 hours of research assistance per week. Students will also meet regularly as a group and will with visiting Washington Forum speakers. The fellowships are each worth \$2,500 and are open to students in all majors and colleges.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- Applicants must be undergraduates at Ohio University.
- Applicants may be enrolled in any college within Ohio University.
- Applicants must have a 3.4 GPA.

APPLICATION DETAILS:

To apply for a Washington Forum undergraduate research fellowship, please assemble the following:

1. Undergraduate transcript/DARS resport
2. Résumé
3. Statement (1 page) of how the GWF undergraduate research fellowship will benefit you.
4. Brief essay (1–2 pages) responding to the following excerpt from John Locke's *Letter Concerning Toleration*:
'The commonwealth seems to me to be a society of men constituted only for the procuring, preserving and advancing their own civil interests. Civil interest I call life, liberty, health and indolency of body; and the possession of outward things, such as money, lands, houses, furniture and the like.'
