



UNDERGRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS, 2020–2021

(\$2,000)

Application deadline: 15 May 2020

OVERVIEW:

The George Washington Forum (GWF) will award up to six (6) undergraduate fellowships for the 2020–2021 academic year. The award winners will participate in a bi-weekly reading group and will meet with all GWF visiting speakers. The fellowships are each worth \$2,000 and are open to students in all majors and colleges. The 2020–2021 GWF undergraduate fellows will also attend a fully-funded weeklong seminar in the United Kingdom (London, Oxford and Cambridge) in May 2021.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- Applicants must be undergraduates at Ohio University.
- Applicants may be enrolled in any college within Ohio University.
- Applicants must have a 3.5 GPA and/or excellent standardized test scores (ACT, SAT).

APPLICATION DETAILS:

To apply for a GWF undergraduate research fellowship, please assemble the following:

1. DARS report
2. Résumé
3. Statement (1 page) of career goals and how a GWF undergraduate fellowship would benefit you.
4. Brief essay (3–4 pages) responding to the following excerpt from Blaise Pascal: *‘Reason’s last step is to recognize that there is an infinite number of things which surpass it. It is simply feeble if it does not go as far as realizing that.’*
5. Reference letter from an Ohio University faculty or staff member
