



UNDERGRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS, 2021–2022

(\$2,000)

Application deadline: 29 April 2021

OVERVIEW:

The Menard Family George Washington Forum (GWF) will award up to five (5) undergraduate fellowships for the 2021–2022 academic year. The award winners will participate in a bi-weekly reading group and will meet with all GWF visiting speakers. The fellowships are each worth \$2,000 and are open to students in all majors and colleges. The 2021–2022 GWF undergraduate fellows will attend a fully-funded weeklong seminar in the United Kingdom (London, Oxford and Cambridge) in May 2022.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicants must be undergraduates at Ohio University
- Applicants may be enrolled in any college within Ohio University.
- Applicants must have a 3.5 GPA and/or excellent standardized test scores (ACT, SAT)

APPLICATION DETAILS:

To apply for a GWF undergraduate fellowship, please assemble the following:

1. DARS report
2. Résumé
3. Statement (1 page) of career goals and how a GWF undergraduate fellowship would benefit you

4. Brief essay (3–4 pages) responding to the following excerpt from Aristotle: *‘Every state is a community of some kind, and every community is established with a view to some good: for everyone always acts in order to obtain that which they think good. But, if all communities aim at some good, the state or political community, which is the highest of all, and which embraces all the rest, aims at good in a greater degree than any other, and at the highest good.’*
5. Reference letter from an Ohio University faculty member.
